The structure may be a little different than most books clubs; each month the librarian facilitator will rotate, and you will receive a reading selection list of five or six books to choose from. Read one or all of them, the goal is to identify appeals and characteristics that make each book unique and to explore new genres together!



Each month our meetings will include the following activities:

- Book discussion/summaries
- Appeals & read-alikes discussion
- Deep dive into that month's genre
- Distribution of the next month's reading list

- **NovelList** - database available through WCFL. Number one source for read alikes and appeals of different titles.
- **Books In Print** - database available through WCFL. Gives information about books, as well as reviews from readers and professional organizations.
- **Goodreads** - free crowd-sourced website. Can help you track reading and see reviews from other readers.
