

Wine Bottle Snowmen

Materials

- Wine Bottle
- White Acrylic Paint
- Black Acrylic Paint
- Orange Acrylic Paint
- Flat Sponge Paint Brush
- Round Sponge Paint Brush
- Small Detail Paint Brush
- Black Felt
- Wire Ribbon
- Scissors*

*not provided in the Make and Take 2 Go kit



Step 1

Start by using the flat sponge paintbrush to paint the wine bottle white. Start with a thin base layer brushed evenly on, and then use the brush to dab generous amounts of white paint all over the bottle. This will create a snowy effect and also help cover the bottle quickly. Once you have covered the bottle, you'll need to wait for the paint to dry.

Step 2

When the white paint has dried, use the round sponge paint brush for the black paint. Start by painting the neck of the wine bottle black. This will be the snowman's hat.

Step 3

Using the round head of the sponge paint brush, make the coal eyes and coal mouth of the snowman.

Step 4

Using the fine detail brush, paint an orange carrot triangle nose between the eyes and mouth. When the carrot is done. Wait for the paint to dry.





Step 5

After the paint has dried, use the fine detail brush with the white paint to add some shine to your snowman's eyes. You can do this by painting an upside-down semicolon.

Step 6

With the painting done, it's time to dress our snowman. Take the felt circle and fold it in half. Use your scissors to cut a small slit in the middle of the semi-circle. Unfold the felt and fold it in the opposite direction. Cut another slit. You should now have an 'X' in the middle of your felt circle. This will allow you to slide your felt over the neck of the wine bottle to create the brim of the snowman's hat.



Step 7

Finish off your snowman with a ribbon scarf. Tie it around the bottom of your wine bottle below the snowman's mouth.

You're Finished!

Add any touches to your snowman that you want. You can put artificial flowers in the top of the wine bottle or add some glitter. Whatever tickles your fancy!
